Purple-Gold Meet:

Attention all swimmers, there will be an intrasquad meet held in place of practice on Tuesday November 21st instead of practice. This will be an excellent opportunity for our new swimmers and parents to get the feel for how a meet is run and to try out the volunteer jobs such as timing. This also will provide the coaching staff with baseline times for all our swimmers for the upcoming meets. A sign up sheet has been posted on deck to indicate if you can attend. Stroke and Turn Clinics:

CPAL requires that the stroke and turn judges used during dual meets complete a 2 hour training class each season. SMSC Teamwear:

Forms:

During the first week, we attempted to distribute informational packets to all the parents/swimmers. In the packet were a picture release form and a swimmer pledge form. Locker Room Precautions:

The locker rooms can not always be monitored by parents and coaches, so we ask that you remind your swimmers of proper locker room etiquette. Horseplay will not be tolerated in the locker rooms. Swimmers are encouraged not to share personal items such as towels, brushes etc. If swimmers forget towels, they can ask for one from the school stockpile instead of sharing. Swimmers should check to be sure they have their caps, goggles, etc before leaving. Items left behind are placed in the lost and found if located by a member of the coaching staff.

We have had several instances of the showers being left on by the last ones to use them. Please turn of the showers when you are done.
